WHEREAS, in recent years, the industry has experienced strong growth and advances in technology that have created a need for additional educated and well-trained professionals; and

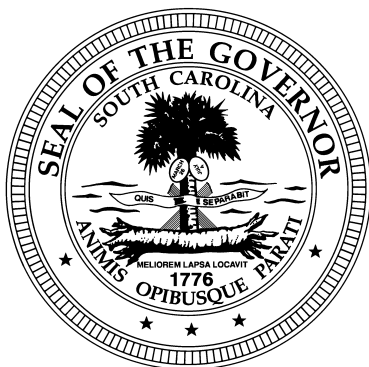
WHEREAS, raising awareness of the employment opportunities available within dealerships can help encourage students to explore the career possibilities offered by the industry; and
