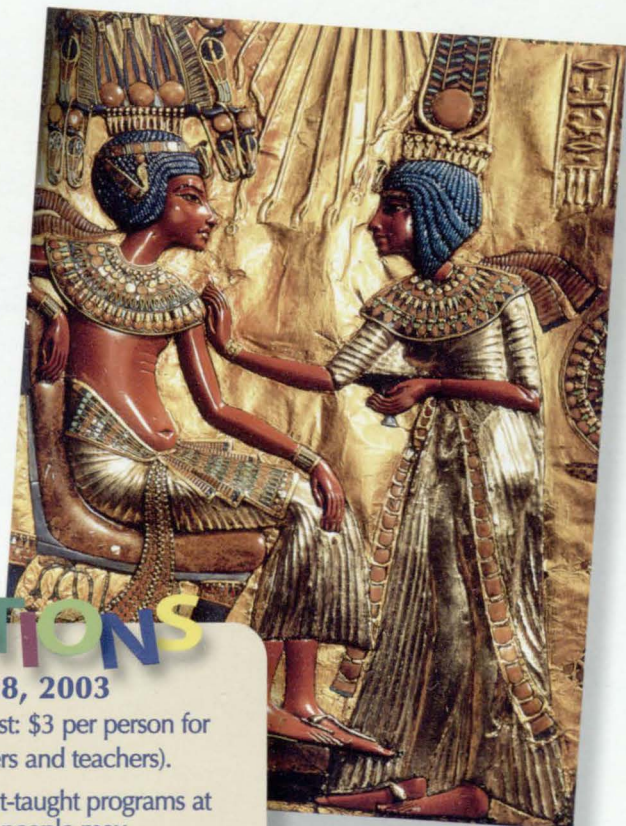
## TUTANKHAMUN

"Wonderful Things" from the Pharaoh's Tomb

January 24 - August 15, 2003

The Pharaoh invites you to visit his treasures at  
the South Carolina State Museum!

Bring your students to experience hand-crafted replicas of objects associated with one of the most famous Pharaohs of African heritage. On exhibit are Tutankhamun's sacred and personal possessions including his magnificent state chariot, thrones, jewelry, funerary mask and mummy case along with actual artifacts from the time period.



### PROGRAM OPTIONS

Beginning Tuesday, January 28, 2003

This exhibit is appropriate for all grade levels. Cost: \$3 per person for ages 3 and up (students, chaperons, bus drivers and teachers).

Available - Tuesday-Wednesday one-hour, docent-taught programs at 9 a.m., 10:30 a.m., noon and 1 p.m. 100 people max.

Self-guided - Tuesday-Wednesday available 10 and 11:30 a.m., 2-4:30 p.m. 100 people max.

Self-guided - available Thursday-Friday available on the half-hour from 9 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. 100 people per half-hour.

The South Carolina State Museum is an educational resource for teachers and students. All educational programs are designed to assist teachers in meeting the South Carolina State Department of Education's curriculum standards.

The State Museum packs a lot of educational programming into four large floors in its beautiful, historic building beside the scenic Congaree River in Columbia, the capital city of South Carolina. Check out the many programs available to

The museum is housed in its "biggest artifact," the renovated 1893 Columbia Mill, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and was the world's first totally electric textile mill.

The exhibits and programs in the museum's four disciplines — art, history, science and technology and natural history — will enable you to help your students meet curriculum standards.

### How do I schedule a visit to the SC State Museum?

**When are school programs available?** Tuesday-Friday from September 17, 2002-May 23, 2003 at 9, 10:30 a.m. and noon. Self-guided tours available weekday afternoons and all day on Fridays. (Check the Tutankhamun information for the special program schedule.)

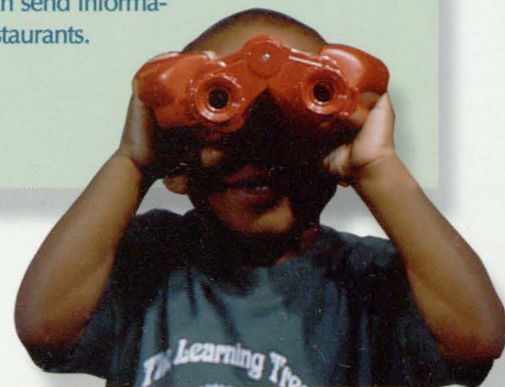

**How much do programs cost?** There is no charge for South Carolina students. (Special exhibits, such as *Tutankhamun*, require a charge.)

**How do I get the pre-visit materials?** You can print them from the museum's website ([www.museum.state.sc.us](http://www.museum.state.sc.us)), or we can send them to you as an email attachment or we can mail them to you.

**How many adult chaperons can I bring?** We recommend one chaperone for every five students but permit as few as one chaperone for every 10 students. If groups bring more than one chaperon for every five students the extra chaperons will be charged the group rate of \$4 per person. Teachers are counted as chaperons.

**Where can we eat lunch?** On site space for lunch is available but limited. We can send information about area parks and restaurants.
