Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder cattle and calves steady. Demand moderate to good. Several large strings of cattle coming off wheat on offer. Raining today and more is expected later in the week. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (57% Steers, 42% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 63%.

Compared to last week: Slaughter cows sold mostly 1.00-4.00 higher on light receipts. Slaughter bulls steady to 1.00 lower. Packer demand mostly good. A total of 153 cows and bulls sold with 45 percent going to packers. Supply included: 75% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 11% Slaughter Cattle (77% Cows, 23% Bulls); 14% Replacement Cattle (71% Bred Cows, 12% Bred Heifers, 18% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
