GOVERNOR ANNOUNCES AVIATION SAFETY WEEK



Governor James B. Edwards signs a proclamation setting the week of May 16 through May 23 as Aviation Safety Week in South Carolina, as John Hamilton, Director of the Aeronautics Commission and John B. Cureton, Chief of Columbia GADO look on.

In his proclamation Governor Edwards recognizes South Carolina's outstanding aviation safety record and commends the officials and individual pilots responsible for maintaining this record. He urged all South Carolinians to pay special recognition to aviation officials and pilots and their fine work in this field.

In observance of Aviation Safety Week the South Carolina Aeronautics Commission in cooperation with the FAA General Aviation District Office has scheduled two important events. The first will be a series of four Flight Safety meetings. The first meeting will be held on Monday night, May 17 at the Sheraton Inn near the Charleston Airport.
