| Designate a lead agency and authority for Zika prevention and response within jurisdiction  |
| Evaluate the need for a mosquito control program  |
| Evaluate mosquito control program to determine current response capacity  |
| Review, update and/or create local ordinances to reduce mosquito breeding grounds (e.g., litter removal, tire disposal, property maintenance, etc.) |
| Evaluate the need for a joint communications and response plan with neighboring jurisdictions   |
| Negotiate mutual aid agreements, intergovernmental agreements or contingency contracts to do mosquito control work, if needed                       |
| Obtain permits and licenses for insecticide application   |
| Collaborate with the SC Department of Health and Environmental Control and other state, local, federal agencies and other community partners        |
| Inform and educate local leadership   |
| Develop a plan to respond to local media questions  |
| Develop a plan to educate your local community about personal protection and citizen involvement  |
