DUI DETECTION/STANDARDIZED FIELD SOBRIETY TESTING INSTRUCTOR COURSE

Class Limit: 25

Course Location: See course schedule for course locations.

Course Description:

This course will take the NHTSA certified Standardized Field Sobriety Test practitioner beyond their current level and build upon knowledge which was presented in the practitioner course. The course will teach the officer how to present the DUI Detection and Standardized Filed Sobriety Testing course approved by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy. Upon successful completion of the course, a complete set of lesson plans, student manuals; video and instructional aides will be given to the student.

Who Should Attend?

Class 1 certified law enforcement officers who are active SFST Practitioners with experience in DDI Detection and the application of SFST's. The candidate must be a certified SFST practitioner.

Proficiency:

Students must score a minimum passing score for instructors (to be determined) on written test and demonstrate the ability to conduct a standardized field sobriety test.
