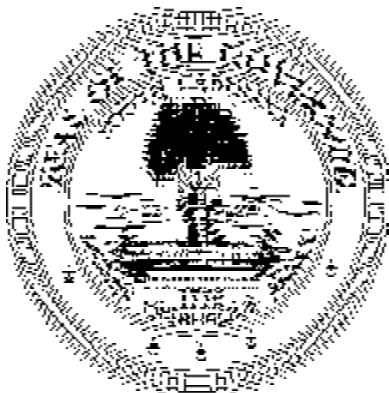
WHEREAS, the South Carolina FFA Association is an integral part of the organized instructional programs in agricultural education in schools throughout the Palmetto State; and
