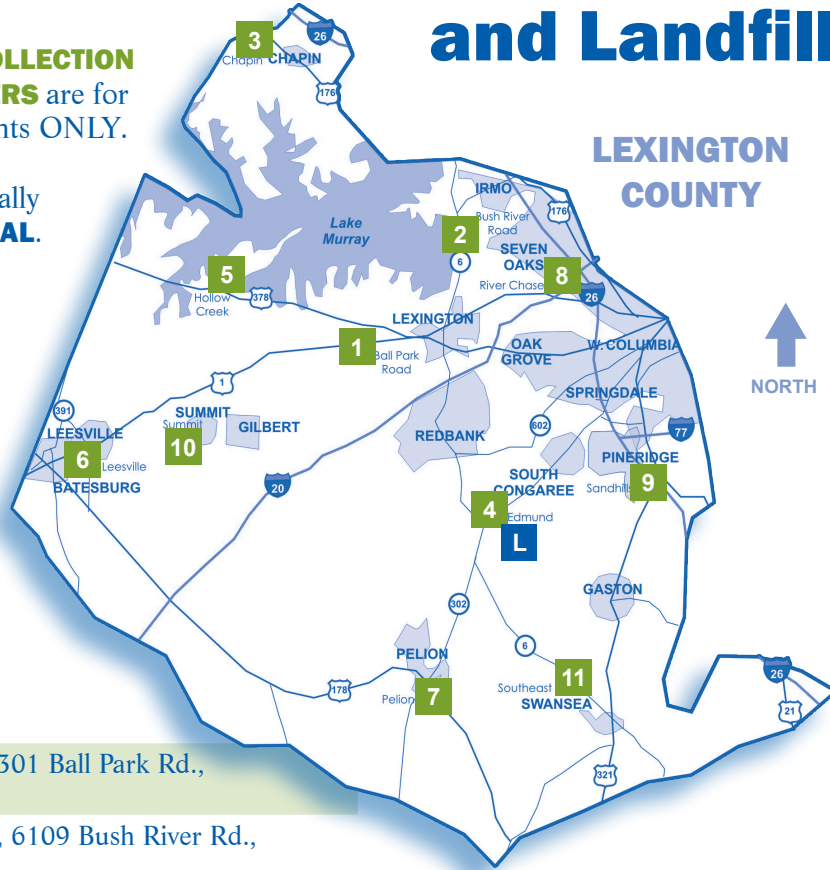

## Lexington County's Mulch and Compost

Lexington County Solid Waste has shredded wood mulch and certified compost available for purchase at the Edmund Landfill.

The cost for mulch is \$10 per pickup load or \$20 per ton. Compost cost is \$30 per ton or \$15 per ton if purchasing 8 tons or more.

\* These items are accepted ONLY at the Edmund Landfill. Handling fees may be assessed. Call (803) 755-3325 for details.

\*\* Loads with more than four tires and commercially generated tires are accepted ONLY at the Edmund Landfill. A handling fee will be accessed.

## Why is recycling important?

- Recycling prevents materials from going into a landfill.
- Recycling saves money and creates jobs.
- Recycling saves natural resources like trees and petroleum.

## How should items be prepared for recycling?

- Clean your recyclables and separate them from your regular household trash.
- Flatten cardboard. This will help save space.
- Keep newspaper, magazines, cardboard and office paper clean and dry.
- At the collection centers, place recyclables in the correct containers.
- When in doubt, leave it out ... or ask!
