#### **SC Homeowner Rescue**

Here is what you can do to apply and get your application in before the deadline:

- 1. Apply before 11:59 pm on the April 20<sup>th</sup> deadline.
- 2. Applications submitted before the April 20<sup>th</sup> deadline will continue to be reviewed until program funds are gone.
- 3. Be sure to submit all required documents so that your application can be reviewed for funding. Applicants are responsible for the timely submission of required documents.
- 4. You can receive in-person help to apply or upload documents at an in-person help center near you. Please visit the link below for a list of these locations and their hours.
- 5. On April 21, 2023, a link will be posted where interested parties may sign up for a waitlist.

### **SC Stay Plus is pausing operations**

Funding from the US Treasury has been fully dispersed to applicants, and it is unknown at this time if any additional funding will be received. During this pause:

- Review of all open applications will be paused.
- Applications will be left at their most recent review status as of March 15, 2023.
- If more funds become available and the program is able to re-start operations and review applications, applicants will be notified by email or phone call if their application enters review.
- The call center will have limited capacity.
- The expression of interest waitlist will remain open.
