Receipts are lighter this week, as producers are having a hard time getting into pastures to gather and ship cattle following last week's severe storms and heavy rains. According to the Oklahoma Climatologist Survey, over the last 30 days the average statewide rainfall was 9.63 inches, which is 5.84 inches above normal for this time of year. More rain and storms are expected towards the end of the week and thru the weekend. Supply included 78 percent over 600 lbs and 37 percent heifers.
