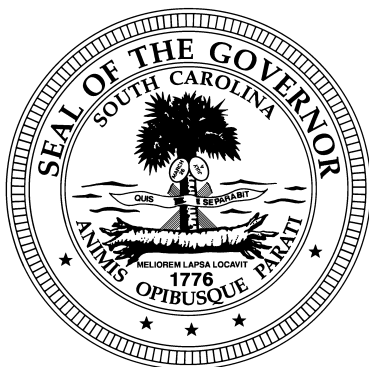
WHEREAS, the information, referral and assistance process empowers individuals to make informed choices through education, affirmation, advocacy, collaborative planning and problem solving; and
