DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERTS – SCHOOL

Class Limit: 20

Course Location: All classes held at SCCJA.

Course Description:

This course is designed for law enforcement officers who have a very definite commitment to DUI and drug enforcement. In addition, the officer's agency must be committed to impaired driving enforcement. After successfully completing this course, the student will be able to describe the involvement of drugs in impaired driving incidents, name the seven categories of drugs and recognize their effects, describe and properly administer the psychophysical and physiologic evaluations used in the drug evaluation and classification procedures, document the results of the drug evaluation and classification examination, properly interpret the results of the examination, prepare a narrative drug influence report, discuss appropriate procedures for testifying in typical drug evaluation and classification cases, and maintain an up to date relevant resume.

Who Should Attend?

Class 1 certified law enforcement officers. Must have completed NHSTA approved SFST course and DRE Pre-School. This class is for officers involved with traffic enforcement and regular patrol duties.

Proficiency: The student must also successfully complete field certifications and a comprehensive final knowledge exam.
