
EXECUTIVE ORDER


PURSUANT TO THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, I do hereby proclaim that the Executive Order issued by me on May 5, 1968, is hereby amended so as to provide that the hours of curfew shall commence at 9:30 P. M. this date, May 7, 1968, and shall expire at 5:00 A. M. of each following day and to commence and terminate at those times on subsequent days until hereinafter ordered. During the hours between 9:30 P. M. and 5:00 A. M. those persons in the City of Gaffney and in an area lying within three miles of the city limits of Gaffney shall remain within their homes and all businesses shall close during the hours of curfew, and further,

The Executive Order issued by me on May 5, 1968, is continued in full force and effect in all other respects except as to the modification of the hours as herein set forth.
