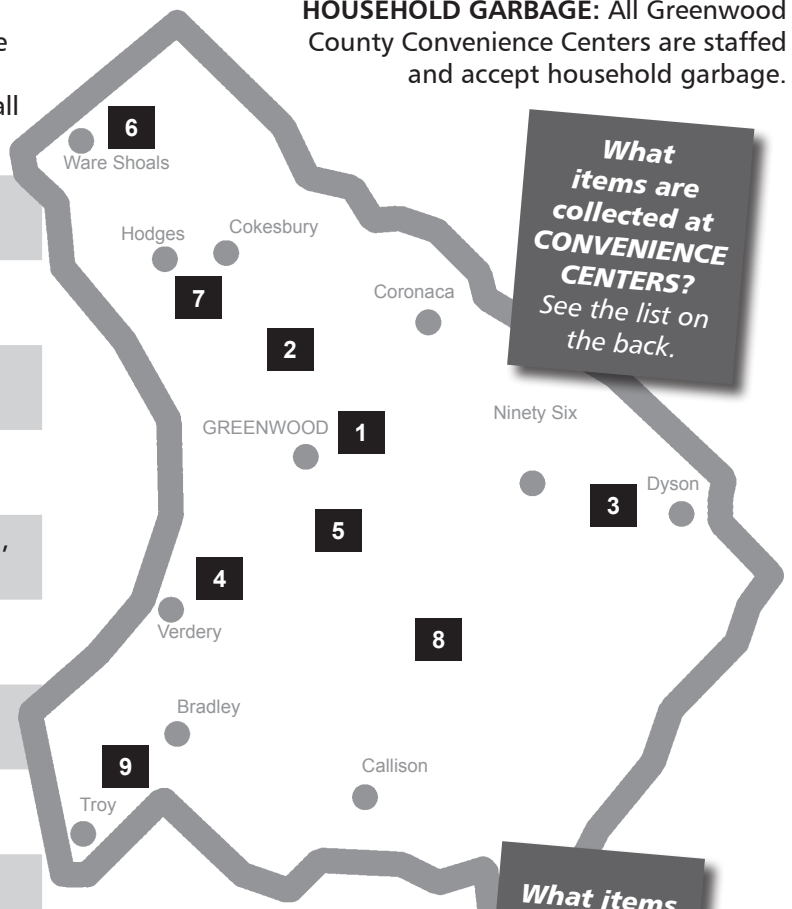


Recycling in Greenwood County is easy!

Convenience Center Hours of Operation

The **Siloam Church Road** center is **OPEN** seven days per week – **Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.**; **Saturday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.**; and **Sunday, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.**

The **Bucklevel, Island Ford, Highway 10, Tedards Store Road, Shirley Road** and **Deadfall Road** centers are **OPEN Monday, Thursday and Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.** and **Sunday, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.**

The **Mays Cross Road** and **Cedar Springs Road** centers are **OPEN Monday and Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.** and **Sunday, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.**

Curbside Recycling

Recycling curbside is now an option in Greenwood County. Call **(864) 942-8567** or **(864) 942-8662** to learn how you can participate.

Recyclables will be collected every other week on the same day. Putting your roll cart in the proper place makes automated collection safer, cleaner and more efficient.

- **Place the cart a few inches from the curb with the wheels and handle facing your home.** Arrows on the cart should point toward the street and the lid should be closed. Choose a level surface on which to place the roll cart.
- **Do not place carts near parked cars.** There should be 3 feet of clearance around the cart to allow the mechanical arm to lift and empty it.
- **Do not place carts within 3 feet of mail boxes or other objects.** Also, do not place them under low-hanging branches.

Your cart should be at the curb before 7 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. After it is emptied, return it to your garage or backyard to keep it safe and clean.

ALUMINUM AND STEEL CANS	Aluminum beverage and steel "tin" food cans and aerosol cans	Rinse. Labels do not need to be removed. Aerosol cans MUST be empty.	Curbside and Convenience Centers
ANTIFREEZE			Siloam Church Rd. Convenience Center
APPLIANCES (WHITE GOODS) AND SCRAP METAL	All appliances with metal parts (stoves, washers and dryers, refrigerators, grills and bicycles, etc.)		Convenience Centers or Landfill; NOTE: Refrigerators and air conditioners must be taken to the Landfill.
BAKING PANS		Rinse – clean pans ONLY.	Curbside ONLY
BATTERIES, LEAD-ACID	Used automotive, marine and lawn mower batteries		Convenience Centers ONLY
BOOKS	Hardcover, paperback and text books	Keep clean and dry.	Curbside ONLY
BROWN PAPER BAGS		Keep clean and dry.	Curbside ONLY
CARDBOARD AND CHIPBOARD	Corrugated cardboard (no wax finish) used for packing and shipping, soda cartons, etc.	Flatten.	Curbside and Convenience Centers
COOKING OIL			Siloam Church Rd., Bucklevel and Deadfall Rd. Convenience Centers
ELECTRONIC SCRAP (E-SCRAP)	Computers, monitors, printers, etc.	E-scrap is accepted from households ONLY. For information about E-scrap recycling options for schools and businesses, please call (864) 942-8754 .	Convenience Centers ONLY
FARMER OIL	Oil from farm equipment	Limit 55 gallons per visit.	Siloam Church Road Convenience Center
GASOLINE/OIL MIXTURES			Siloam Church Rd. Convenience Center
GLASS	Clear, green, brown and blue glass bottles and jars	Rinse. Window glass, pottery, porcelain and china ARE NOT accepted for disposal.	Curbside and Convenience Centers
NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES AND OTHER PAPER	Dry newspapers, inserts, telephone books, unwanted mail, catalogs, paperback books, gift paper, magazines	Carbon paper or partially burned paper IS NOT accepted.	Curbside and Convenience Centers
PAPERBOARD	Cereal boxes, shoe boxes, etc.	Flatten. Remove plastic liners.	Curbside and Convenience Centers
PLASTIC BOTTLES AND JARS	Soft drink and plastic bottles marked by a recycling symbol with a number 1-7 (usually found on the bottom), milk jugs, detergent, soap bottles	Flower pots and Styrofoam (although they may have a recycling symbol) ARE NOT accepted.	Curbside and Convenience Centers
TIRES		Rims must be removed.	Landfill ONLY
USED MOTOR OIL, OIL BOTTLES AND OIL FILTERS	Used motor oil, filters and bottles (oil must be free of gasoline or diesel fuel) and other petroleum products (see list on the right)	Limit 5 gallons per trip.	Convenience Centers ONLY

Items NOT ACCEPTED in curbside roll carts or at convenience centers include: burned items; fluorescent bulbs; hazardous household waste; incandescent light bulbs; liquid waste; oil; paint; pottery, porcelain or china; Styrofoam; syringes (needles, sharps); window glass; and yard trimmings. **Please note that batteries and electronics are not accepted curbside, but are accepted at recycling convenience centers.**
