WHEREAS, the South Carolina Chapters of the National Association of Women in Construction are dedicated to advancing the role of women in the construction industry throughout our state and the nation; and

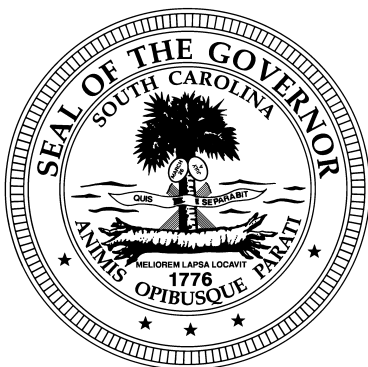
WHEREAS, women in the Palmetto State who are actively engaged in the construction industry work diligently to educate young women about construction careers while supporting state and community education projects related to their field; and
