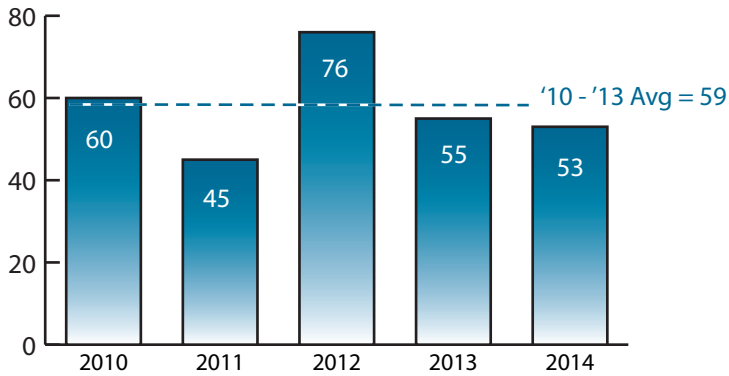

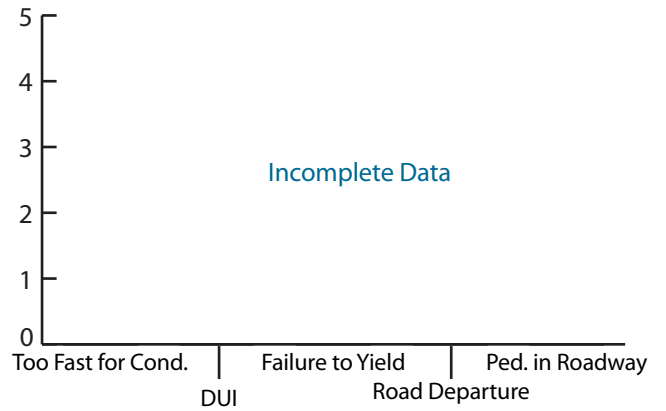

2010 - 2014 Fatality Comparison through January



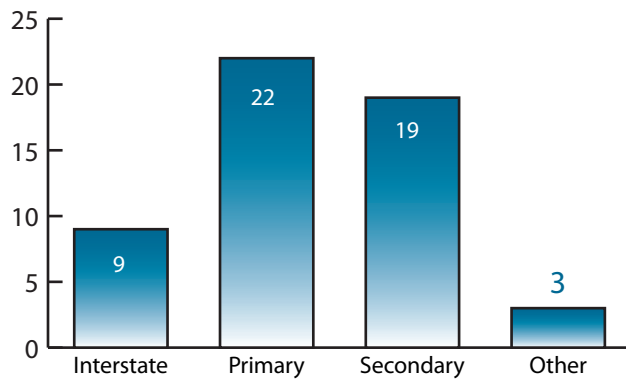
Traffic fatalities for January 2014 are 10% below the previous four-year average and 4% below January 2013.

Top Probable Causes



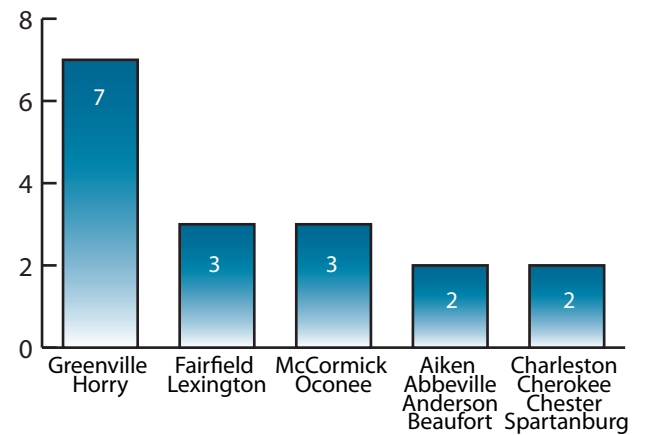
Preliminary data is incomplete for Top Probable Causes since investigations are still continuing for 50 of the 53 fatalities.

Fatalities by Route Category



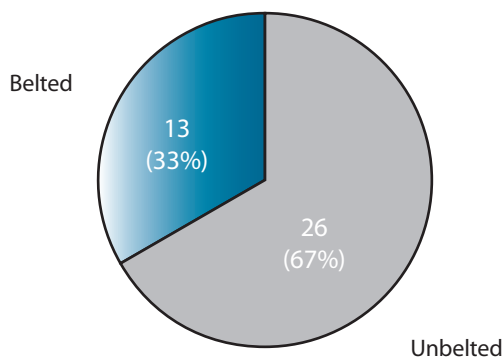
Nearly 35% of all fatalities have occurred on Secondary Roads.

Top Fatality Counties



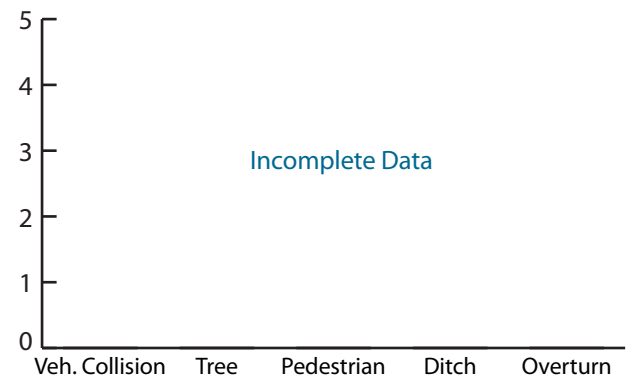
Eleven additional counties have reported one traffic fatality in 2014. The remaining 21 counties have not reported a traffic fatality.
