The Chester County Transportation Plan

1. **Overview:** The Chester County Transportation Committee: (here-in-after referred to as the CTC), is composed of individuals elected to County Council plus County Supervisor. This committee meets on as need basis normally one hour prior to published meetings guidelines.

The CTC will cooperate and work closely with the Chester County Supervisor, County Public Works Director and State Department of Transportation Staff to improve roads and other transportation facilities with the funds allocated.

The CTC will cooperate with the local Area Transportation Study Committee as it pursues its mission of prioritizing primary roads needs in order to ensure the primary and secondary road system of Chester County can best serve the public.

The county-wide transportation plan as adopted by the CTC is submitted to the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) for its approval in accordance with the provisions of SC Code 12-27-400 as passed by the 1993 General Assembly.

2. **Administration:** The Chester CTC is a self-administered county and the County Treasurer has financial accounts that are reviewed on a regular basis by a review team from the C Fund Department of the SCDOT. The SCDOT and Chester County will provide the services including but not limited to the following:
 - Design Engineering
 - Acquisition of right-of-way (primary roads only)
 - Procurement of design and/or construction contracts meeting or exceeding State Procurement guidelines.
 - Projects supervision
 - Compliance with minority and women owned business required under SC Code 12-27-1320.
3. **Priorities:** The goal of the CTC is to cooperate with the SCDOT in maintaining and resurfacing existing state secondary roads in Chester County and to hard surface unpaved roads. As well as to construct and maintain county roads. State roadway projects will be prioritized based on guidelines of the SCDOT and county roads based on the current inventory system.
4. **Resurface and Repair:** The CTC will allocate such funds as it deems appropriate on an annual basis for resurfacing, repair and upkeep of existing secondary roads and bridges.

5. Revisions to Plan: The CTC will, from time to time review and revise the county Transportation Plan, make changes, additions or deletions, which will be forwarded to SCDOT for approval.

6. Goal: The Chester County Transportation Committee's goal is to provide the citizens of Chester County a fair and equitable system of maintenance and paving for secondary roads, bridges and sidewalks which will result in safe and efficient transportation for all.
