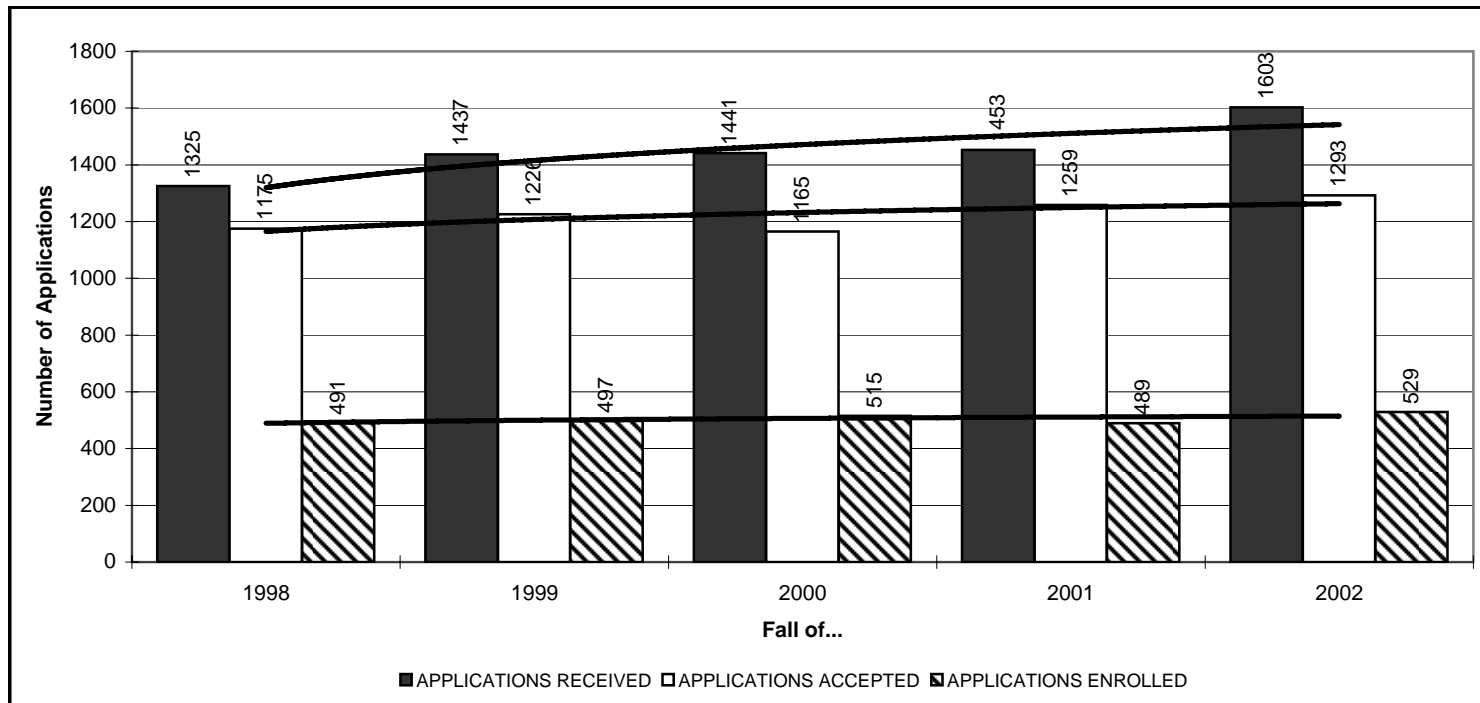

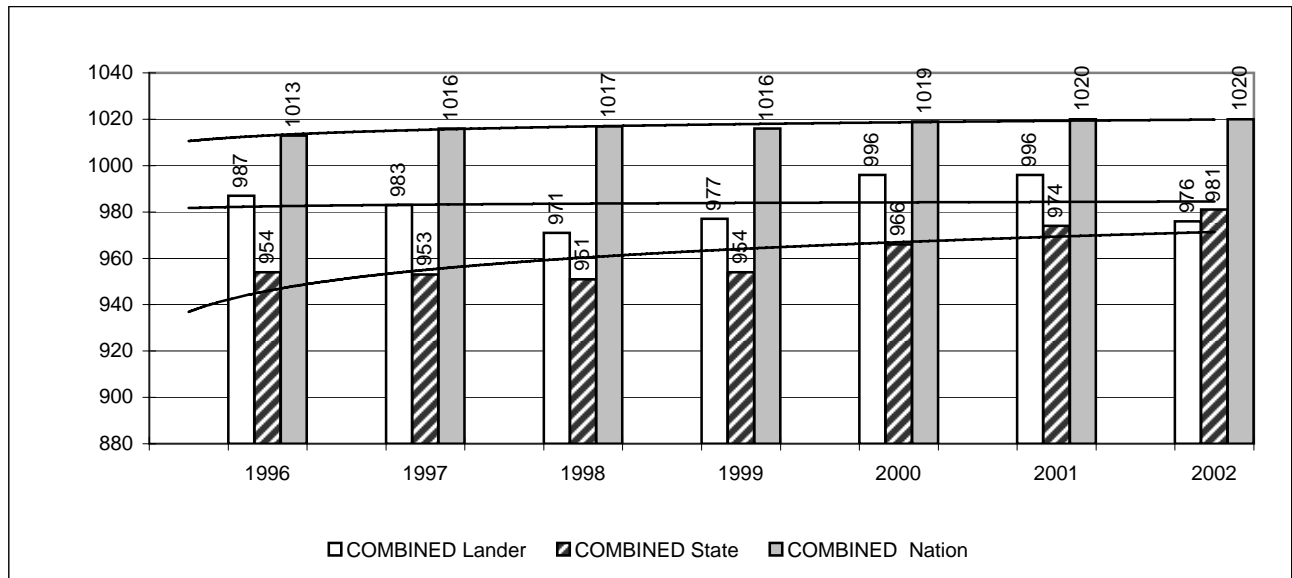

SUMMER CREDIT HOUR PRODUCTION (CHP)* BY DISCIPLINE

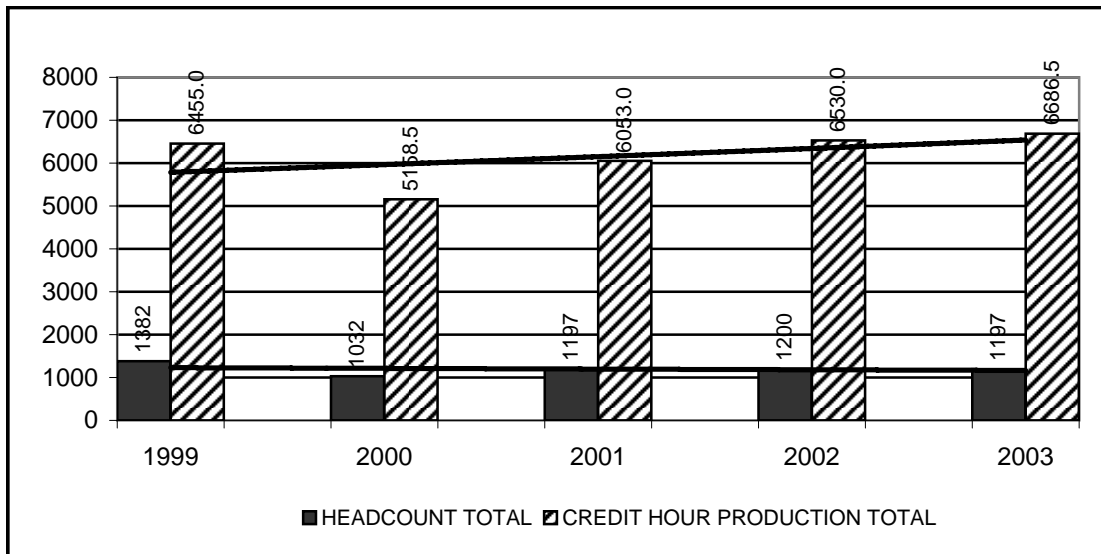

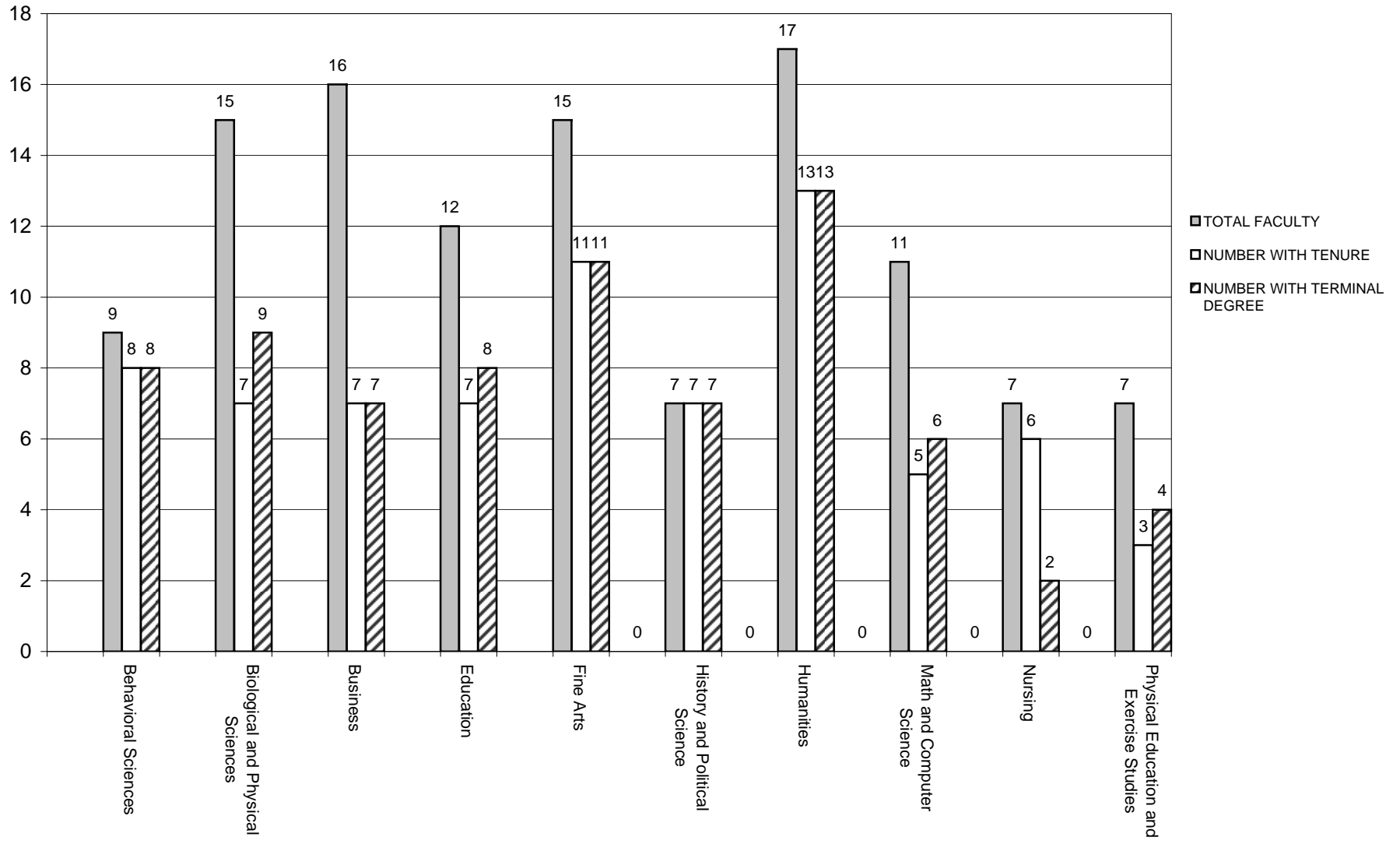

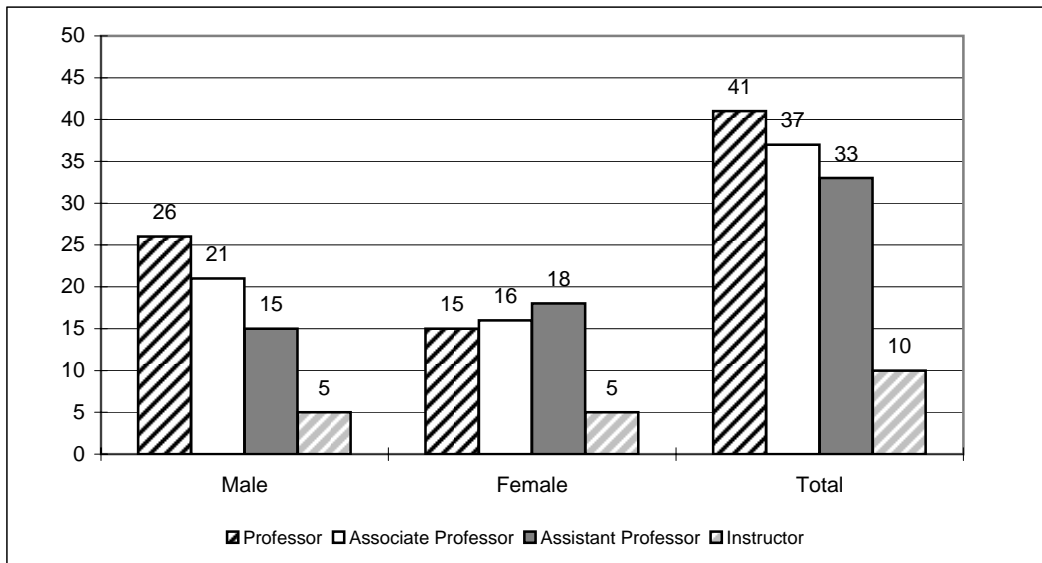
Faculty Headcount by Division/School by Tenure Status and Terminal Degree Fall 2002

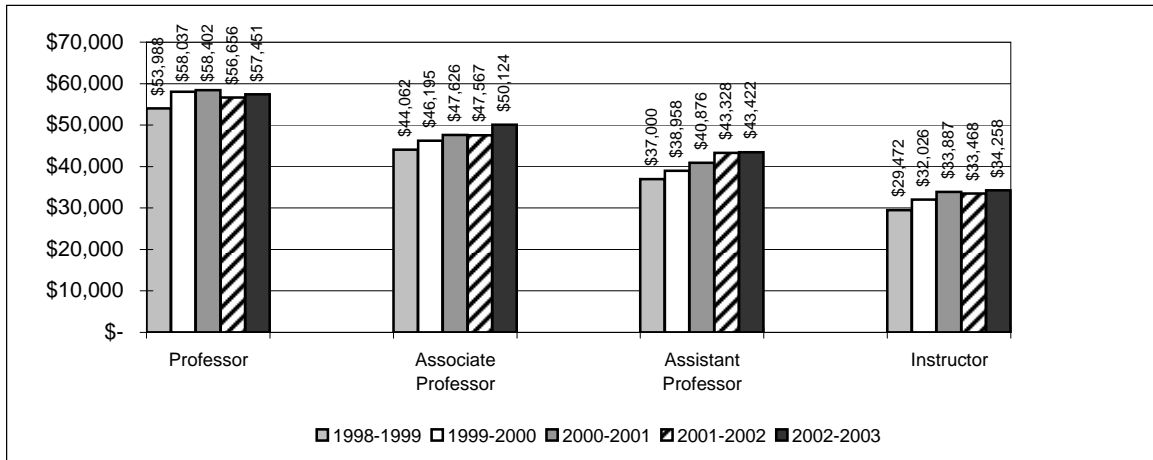
