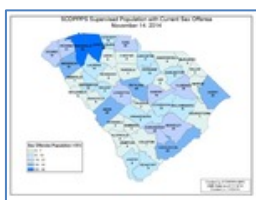

Included in this five year report are evaluation of the value of oyster reefs to other organisms, addressing the issue of marine debris in nearshore waters, restoration and enhancement of oyster reef habitat using alternative substrates to create living shorelines and increase coastal resiliency, determination of the current and historical distribution of oysters statewide, and a collaboration with industry to improve South Carolina shellfish aquaculture through the use of sterile triploid native oysters.



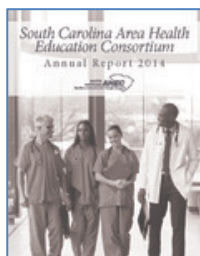

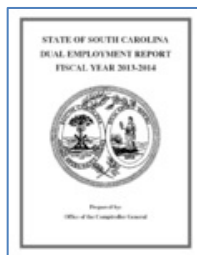

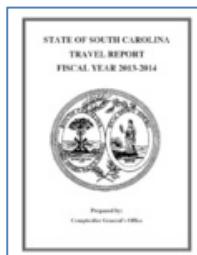
