APRON REHABILITATION – PHASE 3**GREENVILLE-SPARTANBURG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

The Greenville-Spartanburg Airport District will receive proposals for the APRON REHABILITATION – PHASE 3 project at the Greenville-Spartanburg International Airport, Greer, South Carolina, FAA AIP Project No. 3-45-0028-052-2016 until 2:00pm on June 28, 2016. Bid proposals will be accepted in the office of the President/CEO, Greenville-Spartanburg International District. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the stated time or at locations other than that listed above will not be accepted.

SCOPE OF WORK

Bid Schedule A will consist of the third phase for the rehabilitation of the air carrier terminal apron concrete pavement and will incorporate an area from the south side of the “garden area” to the south end of the terminal apron, generally aligned with Taxiway L2, and encompassing the aircraft parking and maneuvering areas for Gates A1, A2, A3, A4, and A6. The project limits extend from the terminal building westward to the apron edge/taxilane edge interface, approximately 300 ft. but do not include the taxilane or the recently constructed slotted slab drain, and is approximately 800 ft. long. Bid Schedule A also includes a full-strength pavement widening section along the western side of the existing taxilane, from the existing widening section to Taxiway L2. Total approximate area for Bid Schedule A is 30,400 SY.

Bid Schedule B will consist of all items described in Bid Schedule A, above, in addition to extending the apron project limits to include the “garden area”. Bid Schedule B includes an approximately 4,800 SY of additional apron rehabilitation.

Three Alternate Bids for both Bid Schedule A and Bid Schedule B provide three different base courses for the Contractor to bid on. The Contractor may elect to reuse materials from the existing PCC pavement as base course in these alternates. Concrete crushing will be permitted outside the AOA fence near the Contractor's access gate.

The Owner reserves the right to select either Bid Schedule A or Bid Schedule B, in combination with any one of the Alternate Bids.

CONTRACT TIME

Contract time for Schedule A will be 300 consecutive calendar days from the date of Notice-to-Proceed, and 340 consecutive calendar days for Schedule B from the date of Notice-to-Proceed, and within the prescribed sequencing as presented in the plan drawings.
